<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Points to a few body parts when you ask.• Follows 1-part directions, like "Roll the ball" or "Kiss the baby."• Responds to simple questions, like "Who's that?" or "Where's your shoe?"• Listens to simple stories, songs, and rhymes.• Points to pictures in a book when you name them.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Uses a lot of new words.• Uses <i>p</i>, <i>b</i>, <i>m</i>, <i>h</i>, and <i>w</i> in words.• Starts to name pictures in books.• Asks questions, like "What's that?", "Who's that?", and "Where's kitty?"• Puts 2 words together, like "more apple," "no bed," and "mommy book."
